

Chamundi Hill Climb Experience – Mysore



Named after the Goddess Chamundi, the Chamundeshwari temple, sits at the summit of this hill. The 1008 step climb leads to the main quadrangle structure of the temple from which one can see the entire city of Mysore, The Palace, Karanji lake and various other temples.

Legend has it that there was once an evil king named Mahishasura, after whom the city was named 'Mahisooru' which means 'The City of Mahishasura'. The great Goddess Chamundi is said to have overthrown the evil king in a fierce battle and has hence been worshipped by the locals of Mysore.

Once a year, during the festival of Dusshera, the deity of the Goddess is taken for a procession around the city, making The Mysore Dusshera one of the most anticipated events of the year with a footfall of over 100,000 every year.

FEES & COSTS

ADULT FEES

(for 13 years old and over, per head)

INR 2500 Per Person

Note: Accompanying officials including bodyguards, are charged the same way as tourists.

KIDS FEES (0 to 12 years): Free (but kids must be accompanied by at least one adult)

Not included in fee: TAX, CAR with driver, Hotel pickups, LUNCH, BREAKFAST, PERSONAL EXPENSES
