

MASINAGUDI



Our tours take you 2 hours past Mysore city, to the heart of the Mudumalai rainforests which are situated in the Nilagiri hills, where the borders of Tamil Nadu, Kerala and Karnataka meet.

The Mudumalai National Park and Wildlife Sanctuary were declared wildlife (esp Tiger) reserve in 2007. The protected area is home to several endangered and vulnerable species including Indian elephant, Bengal tiger, gaur and Indian leopard. There are at least 266 species of birds in the sanctuary, including critically endangered Indian white-rumped vulture and long-billed vulture.

HIGHLIGHTS OF WHAT YOU CAN EXPERIENCE

- Visit an elephant care camp, where they are fed, bathed and treated.
- Visit a beautiful Indian home, which is in the forest and has no fence because the family believes in integration with the animals and wildlife without creating boundaries and barricades.
- A blue mountain train ride.
- A tribal lunch.
- A nature trail/trek.

HOW WE PLAN THE PROGRAM

To make it worth the long drive, we recommend at least two nights stay.

This tour could be clubbed with some pitstops along the way (esp for people who don't enjoy long drives, or have kids on board).

These pitstops could include a boat ride in a natural river surrounded by crocodiles and migratory birds, a village that breeds and cocoons silkworms and auctions them, a stop at the Mysore palace, and a toy factory making wooden toys in the Persian, old glazed fashion.
